Dues Notice:

The dues renewal and boat registration forms are enclosed. Please complete and return both with your payment by April 1. The Board is looking into using "PAYPAL" as an option for membership payment. Check the TLRA website for updates.

Membership Update:

In the last 12 months, more properties around Terry Lake have changed hands resulting in more new members. Help us educate our new members. All new households have received a copy of the TLRA Rules and Regulations.

Boat Stickers:

New boat stickers will be mailed out by the first of May. Please put 2 of these on all your boats and trailers as this is the only way we have of monitoring lake use by members, and it helps in returning "lost" boats.

Matching Funds Projects:

For 2019, TLRA will again be funding projects for noxious weed spraying, shoreline cleanup, fence repair, fish stocking, and preapproved matching funds projects. The 2018 matching funds projects were for shoreline erosion control. Thanks to all of you that participated.

Fish stocking:

No fish were stocked in the fall of 2018, as walleye were unavailable. Fish will be stocked again in 2019.

Hwy 287 and Hwy 1

Additional "No Trespassing" signs were posted along the dam and along the new section of Hwy 287 in an attempt to reduce trespassing. Members please remember that no one is allowed on the dam, including members.

Rules and Regulation Reminders:

1. All shoreline projects from erosion control to simply cutting a tree must be preapproved by the TLRA Board and LWRC from whom we lease the lake.
2. All TLRA members have the right to walk along the East side of the lake from the stoplight at Country club and Hwy 1, north to the end of the lake at Terry Cove, then West along the shore and south edge of the trailer park, then up the drainage between the Terry Point Townhomes to Terry Point Drive, South along TP Drive to the Terry Point boat ramp, then west and North along the shore ending at the cattail swamp near Douglas Road.
3. All guests using the lake must be accompanied by a lake member.
4. Guest boats are NOT allowed due to concerns with Zebra Mussel contamination!
5. Be careful about cleaning and drying your boat and motor if used in another lake.(prevent Zebra mussels)
6. All watercraft and trailers stored on TLRA leased property must be in good working order and stickered.
7. No trailers are to be stored on TLRA property without a boat.
8. Property owners who rent their property or have non owner occupants are required to provide the names and contact information to the TLRA Board.
9. Please do not dump yard waste on TLRA leased property!
