Dues Notice:

The dues renewal and boat registration forms are enclosed. Please complete and return both with your payment by April 1. "PAYPAL" is an option for membership payment. Check the TLRA website for fees and instructions. Fees are about 3% higher due to PayPal's processing fees.

Membership Update:

In the last 12 months, another dozen or so properties around Terry Lake have changed hands resulting in more new members. Help us educate our new members. All new households have received a copy of the TLRA Rules and Regulations.

Boat Stickers:

New boat stickers will be mailed out by the first part of May. Please put 2 of these on all your watercraft and trailers as this is the only way we have of monitoring lake use by members, and it helps in returning "lost" boats.

Matching Funds Projects:

For 2020, TLRA will again be funding projects for noxious weed spraying, shoreline cleanup, fence repair, fish stocking, and preapproved matching funds projects. The 2019 matching funds projects were for shoreline erosion control and tree trimming. Thanks to all of you that participated!

Fish stocking:

Bluegill and walleye fry were stocked in the spring of 2019 and walleye fingerlings were stocked in the fall of 2019.

RULES and REGULATIONS REMINDERS:

1. All dogs must be on a leash or under voice command at all times on Terry Lake leased property.
2. All shoreline projects from erosion control to simply cutting a tree on Terry Lake leased property must be preapproved by the TLRA Board and LWRC from whom we lease the lake.
3. Quiet hours around the lake are from 10PM- 7AM. Please be considerate of your neighbors!
4. All guests using the lake must be accompanied by a lake member.
5. Guest boats are NOT allowed due to concerns with Zebra Mussel contamination!
6. Be careful about cleaning and drying your boat and motor if used in another lake.(prevent Zebra mussels)
7. Remember that all boats are limited to a maximum of 9.9 HP motor.
8. No trailers are to be stored on TLRA property without a boat and they both must be stickered.
9. Property owners who rent their property or have non owner occupants are required to provide the names and contact information to the TLRA Board.
10. Please do not dump yard waste on TLRA leased property! (Take it to Hageman's or the Larimer County Landfill.)
