TLRA Summer Newsletter - 5/15/23

- 1. Enclosed are your 2023 Boat and trailer stickers. Place them on both sides of all your watercraft and trailers.
- 2. New TLRA members, please read and become familiar with the TLRA rules and regulations. You should all have received a copy, but if needed, go to www.tlra.co/pdfdocuments/RR.pdf
- 3. The Terry Point erosion project will be completed this fall by LWRC's engineers and equipment operators. (LWRC Larimer and Weld Reservoir Company owns Terry Lake)
- 4. There will be NO shoreline projects, including tree trimming, allowed this summer due to liability concerns of LWRC management and legal counsel. LWRC will take care of downed trees.
- 5. Please stay away from the island during nesting season (March July 31). If the wildlife's behavior changes, you are too close!
- 6. Trespassers enter from both the North end along Douglas and the South along the dam as well as through Gett's Park on the east and Terry Point's common area/boat ramp. If in doubt, ask if they are members. If they are not members, simply ask them to leave. Call a board member if needed, and they can call the sheriff and have them ticketed for trespassing.
- 7. Beach fires are ONLY allowed in approved fire pits. Make sure they are out before leaving!
- 8. There will be a 5-year membership meeting in December. Stay tuned for information.
- 9. Rules and regulations quick reminders:
 - A. TLRA adheres to all CPW (Colorado Parks and Wildlife) rules regarding boating and life jackets, as well as fishing and fish bag limits.
 - B. Members must accompany their guests when on lake property. No guest boats are allowed on the lake.
 - C. All watercraft and trailers on TLRA property must have current stickers and be functional.
 - D. DO NOT dump yard waste on TLRA leased property. It violates our lease agreement with LWRC! (Take it to the County Landfill or Ewing's Landscape.)
 - E. All dogs must be leashed or under voice command on TLRA property. For problem animals, take a quick photo, if possible. Then call Animal Control 970-226-3647 or Larimer Sheriff 970-498-5100 (Nonemergency line.) and then please alert a board member.
 - F. NO FIREWORKS are allowed, and quiet hours are from 10PM to 7 AM.
 - G. No motorized vehicles allowed on TLRA leased property except to pick up or drop off a boat.
 - H. Remember, this lake is "Use at your own risk" for you, your pets, friends and family!
