Dues Notice:

We will be sending out most dues renewal notices and boat registration forms via email this year. Check your spam folder if you do not see the email by 3/1/24. The annual dues are still \$325 for Active membership. Please complete and return both forms with your payment by April 1. Boat Stickers:

2024 boat stickers will be mailed out by the first part of May. Please put 2 of these on all your watercraft and trailers as this is the only way we have of monitoring lake use by members, and it helps in returning "lost" boats.

Lakeshore Projects

As announced in 2023, **ALL** shoreline projects (erosion control, tree mitigation, docks, etc.) are on hold. The Larimer & Weld Reservoir Company (LWRC) has prohibited these activities by TLRA members. Please report hazardous tree or other dangerous condition to any TLRA board member and we will coordinate with LWRC for resolution. This change was implemented by LWRC and the TLRA board will work with LWRC on a case-by-case basis. **DO NOT** contact LWRC directly. Please be patient as we learn and navigate this new directive.

Fish stocking:

1300 Fingerling walleye, 600 perch and 330 rainbow trout were stocked in Terry Lake in October of 2023.

RULES and REGULATIONS - REMINDERS:

1. Dogs on any TLRA leased property **MUST** be on a leash or under immediate voice command! For any problem animals, take a photo if possible, and promptly contact NOCO Humane at (970) 226 3647, ext.7 or Larimer County Sheriff (non-emergency number) at (970) 416 1985.
2. All boats and trailers on TLRA leased property must have current stickers.
3. All guests on TLRA property **MUST** be accompanied by a TLRA member and **NO** guest boats are allowed.
4. If you are renting your property, the renters' names and contact info needs to be on file with TLRA.
5. Shoreline projects are currently not allowed.
6. **DO NOT** dump grass clippings or other yard waste on TLRA leased property! Take to Ewing's (Hageman's) or the Larimer County Landfill.
7. **ALL** lake activities are "Use at your own risk!"
8. Exercise caution when on the ice. **NO** ice should be considered safe. Monitor changing conditions regularly.
9. The island is off limits from April 1 through August 1 so not to disturb nesting herons.
10. Please remember that TLRA adheres to all CPW rules and regulations regarding fishing and boating.
