5. [Joe] Financial Report

Joe reported that we have collected \$31,750 in dues as of the meeting with 109 active and 15 inactive renewals. The check for the lease payment was signed by Jack and Mary and will be given the attorney for the reservoir company. He also reported that we have liability and D&O insurance in place and that the first six months premium has been paid.

6. [Joe] Use of Insurance Certificates

There was a discussion as to which groups or organizations should be required to provide certificates of insurance to provide proof that they had coverage should there be a mishap o TLRA leased property. There was difficulty defining what a sponsored event was or which groups would fall under the label recognized group or organization. As a result it was left that only commercial contractors hired to do work on TLRA leased property would be required to provide insurance certificates.

7. [Joe] Use of Liability Waivers – Members, Project Work, Tenants/Non-Owner Occupants

Joe suggested that we might want to require liability waivers for members working on TLRA sanctioned projects and for non-owner occupants who would be using the lake. No specific action was taken at this time. Joe will research what is contained in the Rules and Regs and develop and draft waiver form to be circulated.

John presented a status report on the tree and lakeshore cleanup effort. After some discussion it was agreed that TLRA would provide \$3,156 in funds for the project. One of the discussion points was whether this should be a matching funds project or whether TLRA should pay the entire cost. It was decided that TLRA would cover the entire cost of those items that presented safety hazards with the objective of providing a safe environment for boating, swimming, or use of the leased property.. If the item was for appearance or general pruning, then a member or members would be required to pay 50% and TLRA would provide 50% in matching funds.
