- 1. Enclosed are your 2019 Boat and trailer stickers. Place them on both sides of your watercraft and trailers.
- 2. New TLRA members, read and become familiar with the TLRA rules and regulations. For additional copies call Jack Lundt at 970-420-1860.
- 3. The TLRA website, <u>www.TLRA.CO</u>, is updated. Please give us your input. Thanks to Kim Vojesky and Phyllis Jachowski for their efforts.
- 4. Beach fires are allowed only in approved fire pits, and should be supervised by an adult and put completely out before leaving.
- 5. Boat owners, please empty boats of standing water to reduce mosquito breeding grounds.
- 6. Dog owners, there are "Pet Pickups" (poop bags) available around the lake. Please use them.
- 7. Rules and regulations quick reminders:
  - A. All guests must be accompanied by a TLRA member when on lake property.
  - B. No guest boats are allowed.
  - C. All watercraft and trailers on TLRA property must have current stickers and be in working order.
  - D. TLRA members are NOT allowed on the dam from Country Club Road all the way west to the inlet. (Anyone on the dam could be ticketed with trespassing.)
  - E. Do not dump yard waste on TLRA leased property.
  - F. TLRA adheres to all CPW rules and regulations regarding boating and fishing.
  - G. Remember that this lake is "Use at your own risk"!
  - H. All dogs must be leashed or under voice command at all times in accordance with Larimer County Laws. (If you have a big dog, please be careful of the little dogs!)
