Dues Notice:

The dues renewal and boat registration forms are enclosed. Note that the annual dues have increased to \$325 for Active membership as a result of the increasing cost of our new lake lease. ('21-'25) Please complete and return both forms with your payment by April 1. "PAYPAL" is an option for membership payment, but please mail both of your forms back to us for our records. PayPal's fees are about 3% higher due to their processing fees.

Membership Update:

There are now 238 member households in TLRA, which includes over 30 new members in the last 3 years. Please help us educate all our new members. (All have received copies of the TLRA Rules & Regulation's.)

Boat Stickers:

2021 boat stickers will be mailed out by the first part of May. Please put 2 of these on all your watercraft and trailers. This is the only way we have of monitoring lake use by members only, and it helps in returning "lost" boats.

Matching Funds Projects:

For 2021, the TLRA board will focus on erosion control projects and will provide matching funds up to \$1000 for TLRA member's shoreline projects. Thanks to all of you who participate!

Fish stocking:

Fingerling Walleye, perch, and bluegill were stocked in Terry Lake in October, and catchable Rainbow Trout were stocked in November. (TLRA does adhere to all Colorado Parks and wildlife rules and bag limits.)

RULES and REGULATIONS REMINDERS:

1. Dogs on TLRA Leased Property MUST be on a leash or under voice command! For any problem animals, take a photo if possible, and promptly call Larimer Animal Control at 970-226-3647 or the Sheriff at 970-498-5100. (The owners can be ticketed for violations!)
2. All boats and trailers on TLRA property must have current stickers.
3. No guest boats allowed on Terry Lake.
4. All guests on TLRA property must be accompanied by a TLRA member.
5. If you are renting your property, the renters names and contact info needs to be on file with TLRA.
6. All shoreline projects must be approved by the TLRA Board and by LWRC in advance.
7. Homeowners along the shoreline, Remember that TLRA leased property is open to ALL Members!
8. Please do not dump yard waste on TLRA leased property! (Take it to Hageman's or the Larimer County Landfill.)
9. Caution on the ice!!! Stay away from the outlet area. It is unsafe!!!
